

# Comet Customer Service Centre




**Cloughtons has worked for Comet for many years so naturally they asked us to help with refurbishing their Customer Support Centre in Clevedon.**

# Sheffield University




**When Sheffield University was looking to refurbish the Richard Roberts atrium, Cloughtons was asked to help design and supply the new furniture to help update the space.**
